The City Population, Information and Community Affairs Division (CPICAD), a division of the City Mayor's Office has launched its programs for 2018. In March 2018. It started its advocacy campaign on Anti-Violence Against Women and their Children (R.A. 9262) in different clustered barangays. It will continue in July and August. This program is in coordination with the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO).



In April this year, CPICAD conducted a Labor Education Orientation program for students who availed of the Special Program for the Employment of Students (SPES). The orientation training was scheduled on April 23 to 26 and April 30 to May 4, 2018. The speakers/facilitators of the training were the department heads who not only willingly shared their views and expertise on their respective fields but more importantly on the value of work. The topics covered included Vision, Mission and Objectives of the LGU, Environment, Agriculture, Coastal Management, Magna Carta of Women and Character Development and Work Ethics. The culmination activity of the orientation training was the Coastal Clean-up at the Canibol wharf.



On May 9 to 11, 2018, CPICAD sponsored the Gender Sensitivity Training and GAD Plan and Budget seminar for all department heads and assistant heads – the first under Mayor Mercy T. Goñi's Administration. The trainers of the training and seminar were: Dr. Jose C. Columna, Ms. Fritz Lumjod-Zanoria of GAD Province, Ms. Alberto E. Abrio of the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office and Ms. Lovely Absin, LGOO, DILG.

In accordance with the provisions of Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-01 the GAD Focal Point System of Bais City-LGU is reconstituted and a Technical Working Group (TWG) is created. The GAD Focal Point System (GFPS) is the lead in mainstreaming GAD perspectives in LGU policies, plans and programs. The TWG facilitates the gender mainstreaming efforts of the LGU thru the GAD Planning and Budgeting process.

CPICAD will also hold a GAD Plan and Budget Seminar to Barangay Captains, VAW Desk Officers and Barangay Treasurers.
